COMPANY : Café Zimmermann

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Describe your company in a few words :

Founded in 1999, Café Zimmermann is one of the leading baroque ensembles in France and in Europe. Under the artistic direction of harpsichord player Céline Frisch and violinist Pablo Valetti, the ensemble gathers soloists who want to recreate the artistic atmosphere that existed in Gottfried Zimmermann's café in the 18th century in Leipzig. Café Zimmermann collaborates with artists such as Emöke Barath, Damien Guillon, Kristina Hammarström, Christian Immler, Roberta Invernizzi, Sophie Karthäuser Carolyn Sampson and Dominique Visse.

Currently in residence at the Grand Theatre de Provence, Café Zimmermann frequently performs in some of the most renowned concert halls and festivals in France, Europe, United States, South-America and Japan. Café Zimmermann also promotes 18th century music to a larger audience by developing varied educational projects.

Café Zimmermann's CD recordings for Alpha productions are acclaimed by the audience and the press; the spirited and lively interpretation of the instrumental work of J.S. Bach was awarded by a Diapason d'Or in 2011.
